### WARNING:

1. Our PAR90/PAR120/PAR150 are extremely bright, please **DO NOT** look directly at the light as it may damage your eyes.
2. All PAR90/PAR120 /PAR150 **MUST** switch on under the water .

### RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK OR ELECTROCUTION

This underwater lights fixture must be installed by a licensed pool's technician or certified electrician or a qualified pools serviceman in accordance with all applicable local codes and ordinances. Improper installation may create an electrical hazard which could result in death or serious injury to pool users, installers or others due to electrical shock and may also cause damage to property. Always disconnect power to the pool lights at the circuit breaker before servicing the lights. Failure to do so could result in death or serious injury to serviceman, pools user or others due to electrical shock. **DO NOT** connect your new PAR lights the incorrect voltage or you may damage your lights and invalidate the warranty. All Pool lights **MUST** turn on under the water only.

### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

A: Preparatory steps which must be completed by the electrician before lights is installed see Figure 1:

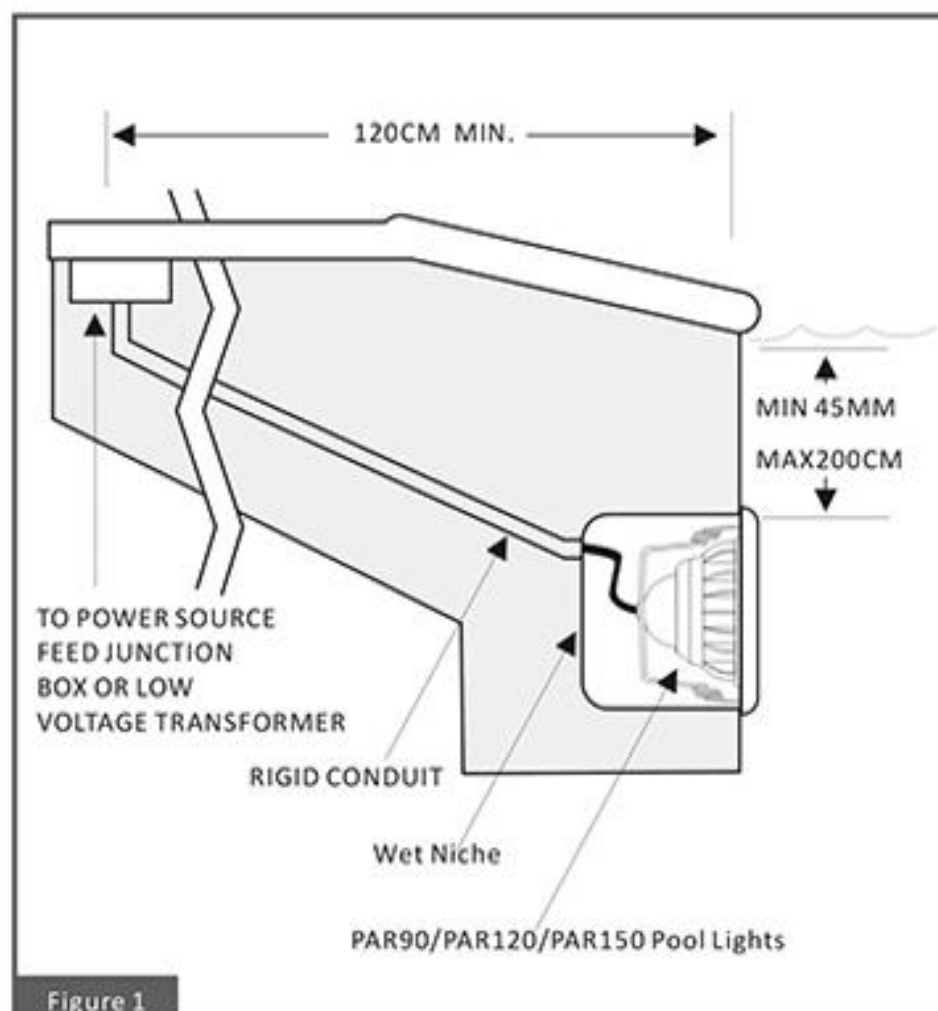

1. Ensure that the electrical system of the pool conforms to the requirements of all the local codes and ordinances. A licensed or certified electrician must install the electrical system to meet or exceed those requirements before the Underwater Lights is installed.
  - a) The junction box, or the low voltage transformer for 12 volt modes, **NEVER SUBMERGE THE TRANSFORMER** is located at least 120 cm from the edge of the pools, and is IP 64 splash rated see Figure 1
  - b) The lights fixture and all metal items within 240 cm of the pool must be properly electrically bonded.
  - c) The mounting bracket must be properly installed so that the edge of the face plate of the underwater light's LEDs are at least 45 cm below the surface of the water in the pools, see Figure 1.
2. Consult the local Government Building Department to be certain that the pool's electrical systems meet all applicable requirements.

## CABLE CONNECTION INSTRUCTIONS



1. Strip the pool lights cable and select appropriate gland suitable for existing cable. The gland should fit the cable firm but not too tight.



2. Insert stripped wires into the screw connectors on back of the lights and tighten with a screwdriver

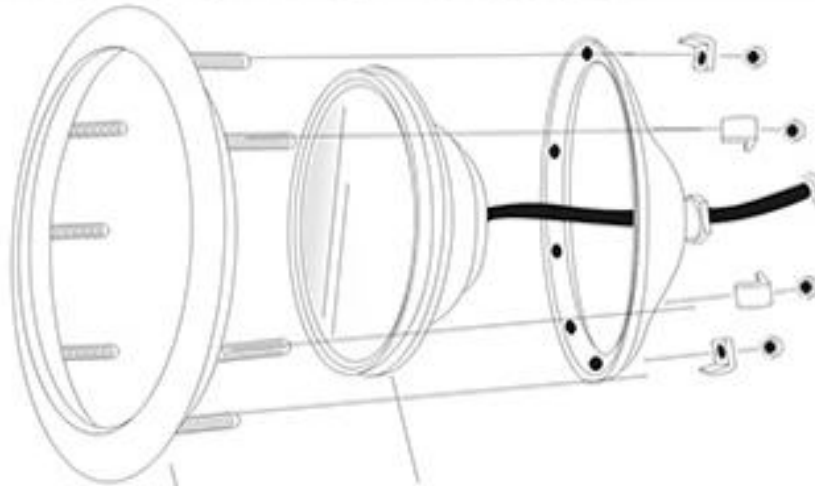


3. Inject the silicone grease into the wire connector and the plastic terminal cover



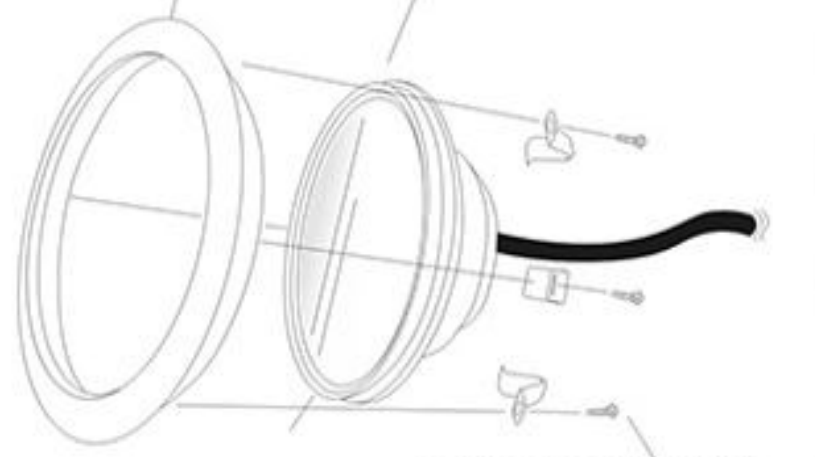
4. Secure firmly with the fixing screw ensuring not to over-tighten and tighten the gland nut

## RGB COLOUR CHANGING CONTROLLER SYSTEM

PAR RGB Lights should be installed on the same transformer and on the same switch. To achieve the synchronization when installing multiple lights on the same line. Make sure each light is installed correctly and on the same circuit. ( Figure 4) Switch the lights for more than 10 seconds, the first colour changing program will started . Turn the lights off and wait for 1-2 seconds and turn them back on. Program will be changed . \*\*If the pool lights are not at the same program. Please turn the lights off and wait 3-6second and turn the lights on . All pool lights program will back to program no 1 \*\*

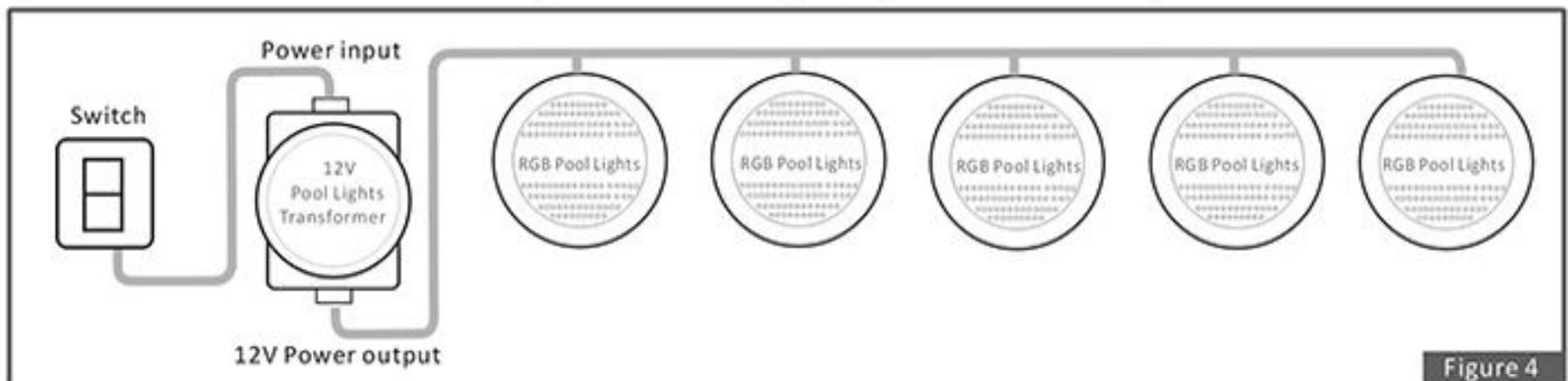
